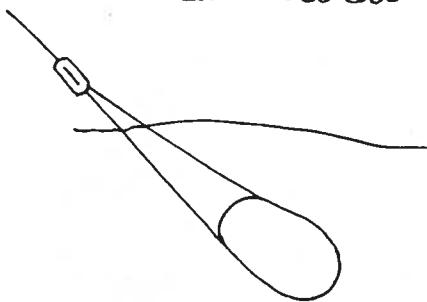




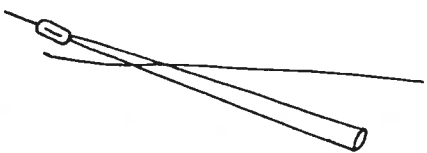
Drive stake into ground at 45°, buried to the head if possible; if not guyline should go round it at ground level.



On stony ground or loose gravel it may be necessary to tighten the guyline around a large boulder.



On snow: tie guyline around stuffsac full of snow which is buried. Stamp snow down on top.



alternatively put guyline around middle of stick or long stake which is buried horizontally.

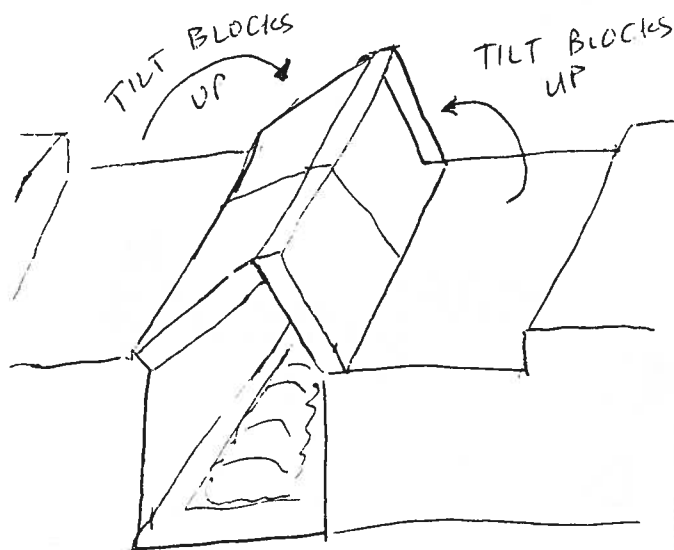
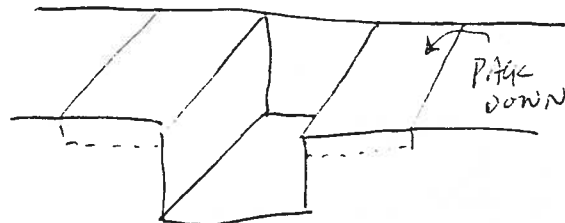


Figure 8-1. Staking out a tent.

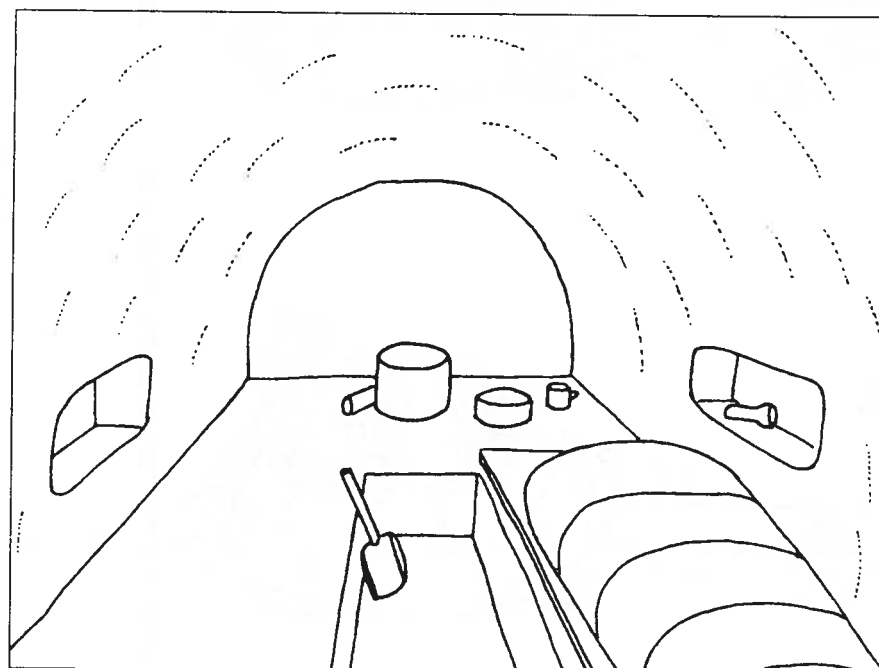
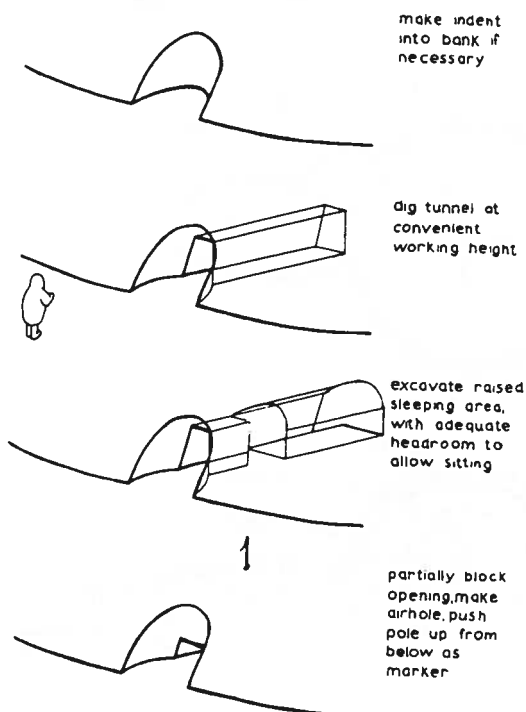


Figure 8-3. Sleeping benches and cooking area inside a snow-hole.
